


**RESOLUTION R-69-05****A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FINAL PLAT OF SUBDIVISION



EXHIBIT "A"

Courthouse Square Subdivision

Legal description:

All that property described as the Courthouse Block, in Warren L. Wheaton's 2<sup>nd</sup> Addition to Wheaton, in Section 16, Township 39 North, Range 10 East of the Third Principal Meridian, According to the plat thereof Recorded April 28, 1869 as Document #11488 (excepting therefrom a 14 strip off the entire northern side of the Courthouse Block which was conveyed to DuPage County by Document R65-26607) all in DuPage County,

And Lot 1(except that part described as follows: Beginning at the northwest corner of Lot 1: thence South along the West line of Lot 1, 50.0 feet; thence east and parallel to the South line of Lot 1, 100 feet; thence North at right angles to the last described line, 75.29 feet, more or less, to the Northerly line of Lot 1; thence Southwesterly along the Northerly line of Lot 1, 105.27 feet, more or less to the Northwest corner of Lot 1 and the point of beginning) in Burckal's Assessment Plat of part of Block 1 in Warren L. Wheaton's 2<sup>nd</sup> Addition to Wheaton, being a subdivision in the West Half of the Southeast Quarter and the East Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 16, Township 39 North, Range 10 East of the Third Principal Meridian, According to the plat of said Burckal's Assessment Plat Recorded March 4, 1933 as Document # 334382, in DuPage County, Illinois.

And all that part of Naperville Road vacated pursuant to Ordinance F-1014 and lying Northerly of the Northern right-of-way line of Liberty Drive (South Railroad Street) and Lying Southerly of the Southern right-of-way line of the DuPage County Parkway (Michigan Street as dedicated In Warren L. Wheaton's 2<sup>nd</sup> Addition to Wheaton in Section 16, Township 39 North, Range 10 East of the Third Principal Meridian, according to the plat thereof Recorded April 28, 1869, as document #11488.
