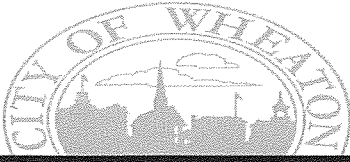

Background: The city’s decision to purchase the above material is based on the following:

- The Public Works Street Department maintains all city street lighting.
- Components of street lights require replacement due to normal wear or unexpected accident. To meet these needs a small inventory of components is stocked.
- The city requires specific poles, fixtures and ballasts to maintain the consistency in design and the standardization of replacement parts.
- These components are restricted to a specific manufacturer and model number. Equivalent designs are not acceptable. Consequently there is little competition.
- These components have typically been bid every two (2) years. Two (2) of the past three (3) solicitations resulted in a second solicitation due to limited responses. Procurement recommends future sourcing proceed as a single sourced item.
